3.2 IT IS FURTHER ORDER THAT:

3.2.1 Residential time with the parties' children, David and Andrew shall be as follows: the children shall reside with Petitioner Sirinya Surina, except for the following days and times when the children will reside with or be with the other parent:

a. Saturday, August 26, 2017, Sunday August 27, 2017 and Wednesday, August 30, 2017 from 2:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Also, Saturday, September 2, 2017 and Sunday, September 3, 2017 from 2:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

3.2.2 The children shall be exchanged curbside at the family residence located at 1616 S. Rocky Ridge, Spokane Valley, WA 99212 by the children's maternal and/or paternal grandmothers. Curbside shall be defined as the beginning of the driveway into the residence. *Attorneys shall communicate regarding other possible exchanges. KAD AP*

3.2.3 Restraints entered by the court August 14, 2017 shall remain in full force and effect including Section 7 and 10.

3.2.4 Section 8, shall include the Restrained person and the Petitioner as to the prohibition against assaulting, harassing, stalking or molesting each other. Further, neither party shall use, try to use or threaten to use physical force against each other.

3.2.5 Section 11 shall also include both parties.

3.2.6 Section 12 restraints are mostly controlled by the Respondent and shall continue to apply to him.

3.2.7 Respondent shall not consume alcohol or marijuana 24 hours prior to visitation or during visitation

3.2.8 Neither parent shall speak disparagingly of the other parent while in the presence of the child nor allow 3rd parties to do so in the presence of the children.
