The children also complain of food rationing, limiting each child to 1 egg a day on some days.. There are padlocks on the cupboards and refrigerator to control access to any food by the children. Recently, the children were found on the south hill roaming barefoot by themselves with another child who is a close friend of DMS.

The petitioner testified on Sept 4,2020 to allowing parties' Children to roam the south hill W/o supervision.
