**REPLY DECLARATION OF:
BANG-OR WILSON**

15 **Bang-orn Wilson Declares:**

- 16 1. I have been friends with Sirinya Surina for nearly 4 years. I have attended most of Andrew
17 and David's birthday parties, Christmas celebrations, BBQs, Sunday dinners. I have
provided day care for her children, especially David. I have taken care of David during
daytime and overnight periods. Until recently, he called me "Grandma". He used to call
19 my husband "Grandpa," but recently has started to call him Carl.
- 20 2. November 2015, when the big ice storm took out power to many of the homes in Spokane,
including Sirinya and Aaron's home, we invited them to our home where they could clean
21 up and cook and eat. We loaned them our emergency heat and electric equipment. Both
22 of them were our friends.
- 23 3. Aaron asked me to write a letter to recommend Sirinya to open a Day Care Center
because she is so good with children. I was happy to recommend her. Not many people I

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- 1 know are as conscientious about the welfare and safety of children. She is a wonderful
2 mother. Her children are her life and the only desire she ever expresses is for their safety
3 and happiness. She has spent her entire life in Spokane in the service of her family.
- 4 4. Aaron frequently came home for lunch. I often visited Sirinya during this time. I noticed he
5 acted normal when he first showed up. However, when he left to return to work, I think he
6 was a bit inebriated or maybe high on marijuana. He even offered to share his alcohol
7 and/or weed, but I don't participate in that and declined.
- 8 5. I have been in the Surina's home when Aaron and Sirinya argued. I was often asked by
9 Aaron to come and help translate language and ideas that he had to Sirinya. He didn't ask
10 me to translate her ideas to him. He is very forceful and very loud. He talks fast and hardly
11 gives anyone else a chance to say anything. He acted like talking louder, helped him to
12 be understood. Sirinya understands only about 15 percent of what he says. Her grasp of
13 the English Language is not strong. She speaks and understands only a little if it is
14 presented slowly and not in an argumentative fashion. She can read the words but doesn't
15 understand most of it without going to her dictionary translator.
- 16 6. Most of their arguments and fights would probably not have happened if Aaron had more
17 patience with her. She always said to me that she loves him and wants to have a happy
18 family with no fights. But, it seems that almost daily she would call or come to the house
19 crying and trying to find ways to work out her problems with Aaron.
- 20 7. Many of the fights were about the finances I tried to help them understand that making a
21 budget would help their financial situation.
- 22 8. At other times, they argued over Aaron wanting to involve the children in activities Sirinya
23 thought were too dangerous, such as snowboarding at age 3. Aaron could have relieved
24 her anxieties with a little more patience. Sirinya is very protective of her children and
25 doesn't want them to be hurt.
9. Recently the arguments got so bad that even when I was talking with Sirinya on the phone
Aaron came into the house screaming and telling her she couldn't talk to anyone, that she
was a Fucking Whore.
10. Aaron's mother was there at the time, and also got involved in the arguing, interrupting
Sirinya's conversation, asking who she was talking to and to stop talking to anyone. Then,

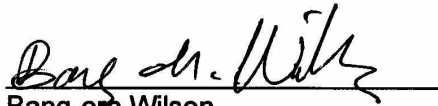
1 Then, to get David away from the argument, Sirinya asked him to go shower, but Aaron
2 told David to not do what his mother asked.

3 11. I have hoped that Aaron and Sirinya could work through their problems. I have tried to help
4 as much as possible by taking care of the children and giving the parents time alone. The
5 children are suffering from the constant fighting and now Aaron seems to be trying to drive
6 a wedge between the boys and their mother.

7 12. When the children are with her, Sirinya is careful to not talk badly about their father, in
8 front of them, it appears from what David brings home after his visits with Aaron that his
9 dad is not so careful. Sometimes David does not want to visit his dad and asks to stay at
home with his mother but she tells him he will have fun and be OK, and that she will see
him in a few hours.

11 I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the state of Washington that the foregoing is
