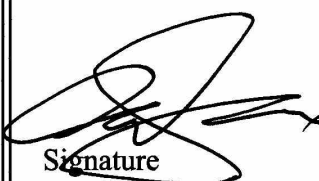

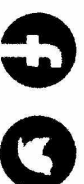

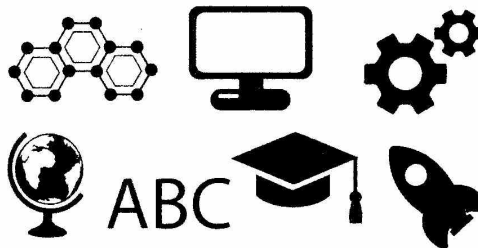

Aaron,

You continue to create emotional and psychological chaos during the return exchange when I pick up the boys. It's not my problem that you decided to move from Spokane to live with your mom in North Idaho. I have offered to meet you halfway @ the McDonalds in Liberty Lake but still you continue to set up impossible situations for each exchange. It is not fair that I have to cross State and County lines just to pick up the boys.

The court ordered parenting plan says that the 1st week of summer and last week of summer vacation are my weeks with the boys with every other week of summer split between us. There is no mention of 50/50 or co-parenting in the parenting plan that Judge Price signed. See attached

Next week is the last week of summer for 2020 as defined by the court.

If I give you next week with the boys I believe that you will in fact owe me 2 extra weeks because the boys were with you the 1st week of summer and they will be with you the last week of summer 2020.

You continue to create emotional chaos during the return exchange when I pick up the boys, from this point forward I intend to follow the parenting plan exactly as Judge Price ordered and I am prepared to go to court and involve the Spokane County Sheriff and the Idaho State Patrol if necessary to remedy any future chaotic exchanges.
