Dear Judge Dixon,

I hope this letter finds you in good health and high spirits. I am writing to respectfully request an extension for the upcoming hearing in the aforementioned case, which is currently scheduled for June 23, 2023. I am a pro se litigant in this matter, and I would like to bring to your attention a significant oversight that has occurred in the process of serving the necessary documents.

Upon reviewing the process service, I discovered that the motion for contempt was not included with the documents served by the process server. This omission has raised concerns regarding the fairness and impartiality of the proceedings, as it potentially denies all parties involved the opportunity to respond adequately to the motion. As an individual who deeply values the principles of due process and adherence to the rules, I believe it is crucial to afford all parties involved a fair chance to present their positions.

In light of this discovery, I kindly request that the hearing be extended to a later date. This extension will allow sufficient time for the motion for contempt to be properly served and for all parties, including those who may not have received the initial motion, to review its contents and prepare an appropriate response. Granting this extension will ensure that the proceedings are conducted in accordance with the principles of fairness and justice that are at the core of our legal system.

As a pro se litigant, I have made every effort to comply with the requirements and procedures set forth by the court. I understand the importance of adhering to these rules, as they safeguard the integrity of the legal process and avoid any unnecessary burden on the court's valuable time and resources. I have personally invested \$95 to ensure the proper service of documents, and I genuinely seek to follow all applicable rules and procedures.

I express my utmost gratitude for your attention to this matter and for considering my request for an extension. I believe that granting an extension will contribute to upholding the principles of fairness, impartiality, and due process that underpin our legal system. By affording all parties the opportunity to respond adequately to the motion for contempt, the court will ensure a more just and informed decision. I filed an objection to reserve the rights otherwise waived without objecting to a move and paid 56 dollars but the clerk questioned if an objection is filed under the same case #. I did not know the answer and could not find it in the local rules or rcw's that pertain to summons and other documents.

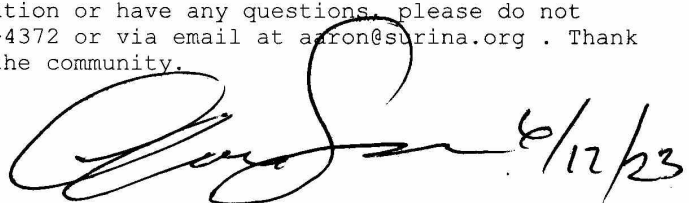
