Restraining Order

This order replaces all earlier Restraining Orders restraining the same person signed in this case number.

1. This Order restrains:

Aaron Surina and Sirinya Surina

2. This Order protects: Sirinya Surina and Aaron Surina and the following children,
who are under 18.

3. To the Restrained Person listed in 1:

This Order starts immediately, and ends in 12 months or upon entry of final pleadings in this matter.

1 **4. Findings**

2 **Authority:** The court has jurisdiction over the parties, the children listed in **2**, and the
3 subject matter.

4 **Notice:** The Restrained Persons had reasonable notice and an opportunity to be heard.
5 The Restrained Persons were present at the hearing.

6 **5. Court Orders to the Restrained Persons listed in 1:**

7 **Warning!** You **must** obey this order until it ends. If you know about this order but do not
8 obey, you may be subject to civil contempt of a court order and payment of attorney fees.

9 **Do not disturb**

10 The Restrained Persons must not disturb the peace of the other party or of any child
11 listed in **2**.

12 **Stay away**

13 The Restrained Persons must not knowingly enter onto the premises or stay in the
14 presence of the other party. If a restrained person enters into a public place where the
15 other party is currently present, the arriving party must immediately leave the premises
16 upon becoming aware of the other party's presence.

17 Both parents plan to occasionally help out at David Surina's school. Aaron Surina shall
18 not schedule occasional voluntary sessions at David's school without providing Surinya
19 Surina 24 hours notice of his intent to do so, via email only.

20 The Restrained Persons must ~~stay away from and~~ not enter onto the premises of the
21 Protected Person's home ~~and workplace. Nor shall Aaron Surina enter onto the~~
22 ~~premises or school, and the daycare or school of any child listed in 2 without the above~~
23 ~~noted 24 hour notice.~~ Both parents are restrained under this

24 **Do not hurt or threaten**

25 The Restrained Persons must not:

- Assault, harass, stalk or molest the other party or any child listed in **2**, including but limited to electronic surveillance or texting or email unrelated to exchanging or appointments for the children; or
- Use, try to use, or threaten to use physical force against the Protected Persons or children that would reasonably be expected to cause bodily injury.

Do not remove children from Washington State Jurisdiction

The Restrained Persons must not:

- Remove any of the children from the State of Washington for the purposes of relocating the children or any other litigation purposes.

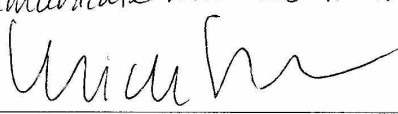

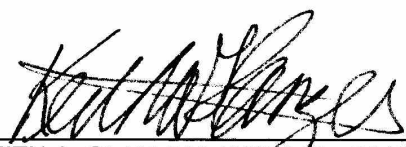

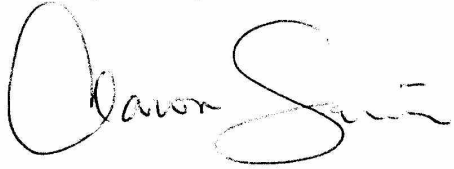
