MOTION AND ORDER AMENDING
TEMPORARY CHILD SUPPORT ORDER

Motion and Order Amending Temporary Child Support Order

I. BASIS

The State of Washington, by and through its attorney, GEORGE W. GAGNON III, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, moves the Court for an order amending section 11 "starting date and payment schedule" of the Temporary Child Support Order entered on September 28, 2017, to clarify that the child support amount owed by Respondent, Aaron Michael Surina, for the time period of August 14, 2017 through August 31, 2017 should be prorated.

II. FINDING

After reviewing the case record to date, and the basis for the motion, the court finds that good cause exists to amend section 11 of the Temporary Child Support Order entered on September 28, 2017 to clarify that the child support owed by Respondent, Aaron Michael Surina, for the time period of August 14, 2017 through August 31, 2017 should be prorated.

III. ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that section 11 of the Temporary Child Support Order entered on September 28, 2017, is hereby amended to read:

11. Starting date and payment schedule

The monthly child support amount must be paid starting August 14, 2017 on the following payment schedule:

In two payments each month: $\frac{1}{2}$ by the 1st and $\frac{1}{2}$ by the 15th day of the month.

The prorated amount of child support owed for the time period of August 14, 2017 through August 31, 2017 will be \$850.14. ($\$1,464.00/31 \text{ days} = \$47.23 \text{ per day} \times 18 \text{ days} = \850.14).

All other provisions of the Temporary Child Support Order entered September 28, 2017 shall remain in full force and effect.
